For peace of mind, we also operate an after hours phone support service that case managers, staff, people we support and their families can access when needed for emergency staffing issues and incident support.

This service is available anywhere in Victoria. It can be privately funded or accessed through an Individual Support Package (ISP), such as Department of Human Services funding.
