ABOUT AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Vista After School Activities is a reliable, safe and enjoyable program for primary school-aged children.

Many parents are unable to collect their children as soon as school finishes, so this inexpensive alternative to child care is conveniently based within the school grounds.

Programs are developed to capture the children's interests and local events, such as community festivals and public celebrations. We provide a blend of indoor and outdoor, planned and spontaneous activities.

Staff are flexible and aim to provide a fun and enjoyable service that provides equal access and meets the diverse range of needs of primary school-aged children.

WHAT IS PROVIDED?

We provide children with constant supervision and care through a structured program that includes a range of activities, as well as free time. Children can also request additional materials and equipment, or a particular activity or game.

We offer a range of tasty, healthy food and drink to cater to dietary requirements and allergies, which sees children through until dinner time.

WHAT ARE THE FEES & REBATES?

As a non-profit organisation, our fees are very reasonable and are designed to cover costs only.

Parents are also entitled to apply for the government's Child Care Benefit as well as the Child Care Rebate, which reduce the out-of-pocket costs significantly.

LICENSING & ACCREDITATION

Vista After School Activities is licensed under the current Children Services Act and Children Services Regulations. We are also registered for accreditation with the National Childcare Accreditation Council.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Vista After School Activities operates in a number of schools across Victoria for primary school-aged children.

After School Activities commences once the end-of-day bell rings at the school, and finishes at 6 pm each school day during term time.
